Garbage is collected every week. Recyclables are collected every other week on garbage day. Visit our website or call the street department to determine if your recyclables are picked up on "A" or "B" weeks. Place your carts out the night before collection day to avoid being missed!

HOL = No pick up on that day. All collection days on the HOL and after the HOL will occur a day later.

HHW = Household Hazardous Waste Clean Sweep Program - see reverse for details.

Yard Waste Collection, Chipping Collection, Leaf Collection, Christmas Tree Collection occur on your garbage day as shown on the calendar - regardless of recycling "A" or "B" weeks.

PLEASE NOTE: Last leaf collection for 2012 will be the week of November 26 on your garbage day.

HELPFUL INFORMATION

CART PLACEMENT

- * Must be 3-5 feet away from each other and from any obstacle (ie: mailbox, parked car on roadway, etc).
- * Must be placed curbside by 6:30 am (**placed curbside the night before is recommended**).
- * The front of the cart (where the serial number is printed) must face the road.
- * Lids must close completely on the carts.
- * **Winter placement:** on your driveway after you have cleared it of snow. Do **NOT** place on top of snowbanks.
- * If your cart is tagged for a violation, it will not be collected until your next regularly scheduled collection day.

CURBSIDE RECYCLING

- * Place all recyclable materials loose in the recycling cart.
- * **DO NOT** use or dispose of plastic bags of any kind in your recycling cart.
- * Plastic motor oil bottles are **NOT** recyclable! Put plastic motor oil bottles in the trash.
- * Excess paper and cardboard recyclables can be dropped off (at no charge) in the crates at:
Paper Valley Recycling - 1420 Earl St, Menasha, Mon - Fri between 7:00 am - 3:30 pm.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Items can be taken to the Winnebago County Recycling Facility - Call or visit the County website for details.

Acceptable Household Hazardous items:

Automotive - fuel additives, transmission, brake and starter fluids.

Cleaners - drain, oven and household; turpentine, solvents, varnish/stain, pool chemicals, polishes and aerosol sprays.

Lawn/Garden - herbicides, insecticides, fungicides, weed killer, and poisons.

Misc. - household batteries, oil & lead based paint, grease & rust solvents, paint thinners/strippers, adhesives/driveway sealer, wood preservatives, spray paint, mercury.

Electronics can be taken to Winnebago County Recycling Facility 920-232-1850 *Limit of 4 computers/TVs per person.*

- Television or Computer Monitor - \$2.00
- Keyboard, mouse, speakers, cords, cell phones - no charge
- Laptop Computer, CPU, Printer, VCR - \$2.00

American TV (733-1000), Office Depot, Best Buy & Paper Valley Recycling Center also recycle electronics.

PAINT

Latex paint - once the paint is dry, put the cover back on and dispose of in the trash

(paint can be dried by allowing it to air dry or by adding sand, kitty litter or latex paint hardener).

Oil and Lead based paint - treat as Household Hazardous Waste.

BULKY ITEMS COLLECTION

Local Salvage Dealer – Check the phone directory for local dealers who will dispose of your items.

Veolia E.S. - You must call 1-800-688-4285 to make arrangements for this curbside service:

- White goods with refrigerants (refrigerator, freezer, air-conditioner, dehumidifier) - \$72.93
- White goods without refrigerants (stove, washer, dryer, console tv, dishwasher, water heater) - \$63.21
- Microwave Oven - \$42.54
- Mattress, box spring, sofa, chair, carpet (bundled in 4' x 4' sections) - \$42.54
- Automobile tire with rim - \$36.47
- Automobile tire without rim - \$30.39

Winnebago County Landfill - 100 W. County Rd Y, Oshkosh, 920-727-2884

Hours: Monday - Friday 7 am-3 pm Saturdays 7 am-12 Noon

Resident must transport the items to the landfill. All loads must be secured with a tarp to enter the landfill.

- White goods with refrigerants - \$13.00
- White goods without refrigerants - \$5.00
- Car tires (16" or less) - \$3.00 each (more than 5 tires are charged by weight)
- Bulbs - fluorescent, incandescent, compact, circular, u-tube, flood, spot, etc. - \$0.25 each
- Propane tanks - \$5.00

◆ **USED ENGINE OIL DROP-OFF SITE** - *Town of Menasha Municipal Complex*

- * Clean used engine oil only.
- * Drop-off site is open 24/7.
- * Drop-off site is monitored by security cameras.
- * You **MUST** take your empty containers home with you.
- * *The drop-off site is located on the west side of the Municipal Complex. Look for the large, white holding tank.*

◆ **TREE AND BRUSH CHIPPING** - *performed by street laborers*

- * Tree & brush material will be collected on your regular garbage collection day, as indicated on the calendar.
- * Tree & brush material must be placed curbside by 6:30am & no earlier than 48 hours prior to your regular garbage day.
- * In the event town crews can't complete the collection route on your scheduled day, collection will continue the following day until the routes are completed.
- * Place branch piles in a single row with all "cut ends" toward the road; piles shall not exceed 5 ft. in height; branches cannot exceed 6 inches in diameter. Keep branches long for the safety of our crew.
- * If you missed your scheduled pick up, you can take the material to the drop-off site at 1422 E. Shady Lane.
- * Violations of the Tree and Brush Chipping Policy will be tagged. Failure to remove such material within 24 hours could result in a citation being issued for violation of Town of Menasha Ordinance 10.03(7).
- * If you hire a professional service to cut down a tree(s)/brush, they shall remove the materials.
- * The entire Tree and Brush Chipping Program Policy can be found on the town's website.

◆ **YARD WASTE & LEAF COLLECTION** - *performed by Veolia Environmental Services*

- * Yard waste/leaf collection occurs every other week, on your garbage day, as indicated on the calendar.
- * Yard waste includes: bundled twigs and sticks (bundles are not to exceed 4 ft. in length, 2 ft. in diameter and must weigh less than 50 pounds), stumps, roots or shrubs with intact root balls, clean woody vegetative material no greater than 6 inches in diameter and garden debris.
- * Use biodegradable paper bags or containers with lifting handles (30 gallon capacity).
United plastic bags should be used as a last resort when preparing leaves for pick up, as they are not biodegradable.
- * **Grass clippings are NOT collected curbside. Grass clippings/leaves/yard waste is NOT accepted at drop-off site.**
- * Bagged grass clippings must be taken to the Winnebago County Landfill in Oshkosh.

◆ **UNWANTED / EXPIRED (PRESCRIPTION & OVER-THE-COUNTER) MEDICATION DISPOSAL**

PLEASE DO NOT FLUSH MEDICATIONS DOWN THE DRAIN OR THROW IN THE TRASH!

Appleton Police Dept - 222 S. Walnut St, Neenah Police Dept - 2111 Marathon Av & Oshkosh Police Dept - 420 Jackson St all have a medication drop box located in the lobby for expired or unwanted human or pet medications in the form of pills, capsules, ointments, liquids, sprays, drops, creams, inhalers or any other drug no longer needed for its intended use. The drop boxes are available any day, any time, for your convenience, **FREE OF CHARGE!**
