

**PUBLIC NOTICE TO ALL CUSTOMERS OF THE  
TOWN OF MENASHA UTILITY DISTRICT**

The Town of Menasha Utility District has filed an application with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSCW) to increase water rates. The increase is necessary due to a 16 percent increase in gross plant investment (including two new wells, new water main, pumping equipment, and hydrants) and a 20 percent increase in operating expenses since the last water rate case was completed in 2008.

If the request is granted, the annual increase in water rates is estimated to be \$879,286 which will result in an overall increase of 24% over the water utility's present revenues. The water bill for an average residential customer with a 5/8-inch meter who uses 11,000 gallons of water per quarter will increase from \$58.58 to \$69.92, or 19% (not including public fire protection), and will increase from \$67.46 to \$83.06, or 23% (including public fire protection).

A telephonic public hearing on the application has been scheduled for Wednesday, February 1, 2012, at 10:00 a.m. in the Arden Tews Assembly Room, Town of Menasha Municipal Complex, 2000 Municipal Drive, Neenah, Wisconsin. Scheduling questions regarding this hearing may be directed to the PSCW at (608) 266-3768.

A person may testify in this proceeding without becoming a party and without attorney representation. A person may submit this testimony in one of the following ways:

- **Web Comment.** Go to the PSCW's web site at <http://psc.wi.gov>, click on the "Public Comments" button on the side menu bar. On the next page select the "File a comment" link that appears for docket number 3550-WR-105. Web comments shall be received no later than the day before the hearing.
- **Oral Comment.** Spoken testimony at the public hearing session.
- **Written Comment.** Instead of speaking at the hearing, write out a comment and submit it at the public hearing session.
- **Mail Comment.** All comments submitted by U.S. mail shall be received no later than the day before the hearing. A mail comment shall include the phrase "Docket 3550-WR-105 Comments" in the heading, and shall be addressed to:
